## HOLY COMMUNION

One: When we gather here, we have a glimpse of the holy city, where God is at work making all things new. The one who is the Alpha and the Omega invites us to the banquet.

One: God is with you.

**Many: And also with you.**

One: Lift up your hearts.

**Many: We lift them up to God.**

One: Let us give thanks to our God.

**Many: It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

One: At the right time Jesus came and dwelt among us, as one of us, bringing good news to the poor, healing the sick, raising the dead, sharing a table with the unrighteous, and teaching the way that leads to life.
